

Privacy

1. The user can access www.walking-event.com without having to provide any personal information.
2. There are different moments in which the user may freely provide information.
 - a) When requesting information or the user wants to book any of the services, in this case the user introduces his name, his e-mail address, and some personal data on the services.
 - b) WHEN RESERVING, in this case the user introduces his personal details such as name, address, telephones, ID, shipping address, ... and the reservation he has requested from the providers of the walking event.
3. The data provided by the users will be incorporated into the computerized files of DXM or their suppliers, making us responsible for their digital treatment and confidentiality based on the following rules:
 - 3.1. The data collected on this website will be used with the aim, in the form and with the limitations and rights gathered in the Organic Law 15/1999, on the Protection of Personal Data, within the framework of Belgian Law.
 - 3.2. DXM has adopted the necessary technical and organizational measures to guarantee the security and integrity of the data, so as to avoid its alteration, loss, or unauthorized treatment or access.
 - 3.3. The users that provide personal data, agree that the aforementioned data be subjected to digital treatment in order to be used by DXM, with a commercial customization purpose, an operative and statistical purpose, and activities that correspond to its social object, expressly authorizing DXM to extract, store data and marketing studies in order to adequate their offers to the particular profile. DXM will provide the necessary details to the corresponding supplier when the user contracts any service provided by this supplier. DXM may retain the user's data once it has ended the relation with the user to meet legal obligations.
 - 3.4. In the eventuality of the collected data being used for a purpose different than that for which it has been collected, it will require the previous consent of the interested parties.
 - 3.5. The user gives his consent and authorises DXM to provide the following details to the official bodies that so require it in accordance with the law of each of the countries in which we operate.
 - 3.6. The user authorize the Company DXM to the use of their image and photographs taken during the Walking Event .The image and photographs could be used for any audiovisual support, purposes of reproduction, public communication, advertising and promotion.
4. The users, in agreement with the Organic Law 15/1999, on the Protection of Personal Data, will be able to freely exercise the rights to opposition, access and information, rectification, cancellation of their details and revocation of his authorisation without retroactive effects on the specified terms. These rights can be exercised by addressing in written form the department responsible for the automated file: DXM in Antwerp, A.Sniedersstraat 35.

SECURITY

DXM and their suppliers adopted the necessary technical and organizational measures to guarantee the security and integrity of the data, as well as to avoid its alteration, loss, treatment or unauthorised access.

This guarantee will be based on an additional two conditions:

1. Secure server

When you are asked to provide personal data, regardless of the security system, you will have the certainty that a business is secure when a closed padlock appears in the lower part of the browser.

2. DXM and her suppliers will never store critical data such as credit cards and bank accounts.

When you choose to pay with credit card or by bank transfer, suppliers of DXM will redirect you directly to the payment gateway of a financial institutions, which use the safest means in order to guarantee your tranquillity.
